OUR PROCESS

Site Assessment

Subject to the scale of the project, our arborists can advise suitable nesting boxes. For larger sites, a fauna survey conducted by one of our partner ecologists would provide greater understanding of existing biodiversity and habitat needs.

Design Phase

We or our partner ecologist will plan the habitat enhancement strategy, including species targeting and box placement.

Installation

Our qualified arborists install nesting boxes via climbing or elevated work platforms. Nest boxes are securely and strategically placed at heights and orientations best suited for the target species. Each box is designed to move along its mounting screws as the host tree grows, providing years of maintenance-free use.

Monitoring

If required we can provide ongoing (12-18 month) assessments to track wildlife use, adjust strategies, and ensure the longevity of the nest box. Like a naturally formed tree hollow, many different species (native and non-native) may share or compete for the habitat.

SPECIFICATIONS

Dual Wall Construction

- Uses an air gap as insulation (fully vented sides, base and roof).
- The ventilated air gap regulates and creates a stable internal temperature and allows condensation and moisture to escape.
- The cavity vents allow moisture ingress to drain.

Steady Growth Tree Mounting System

- Made using Class 1 hardwood timbers, resistant to fire and decay.
- Class 1 hardwood timbers are expected to last 40+ years above ground.
- 2 x large SPAX corrosion resistant fixings, rated to 250kg each.
- Safe, durable and allows for tree growth

Sustainable Materials

- Australian certified hardwoods (not imported plywood or softwood).
- Australian made, certified Weathertex (not glued plywoods).
- German SPAX EN ISO 3506 compliant A2 stainless steel screws (will not rust, no galvanic corrosion).
- 100% Solar power used within our three micro-factories.

Estimated lifespan of 25+ years

- The design and materials will significantly outlast typical plywood or wooden nest boxes
- Infinitely replaceable and repairable parts, no glues or staples are used.

INSTALLATION, MONITORING & REGISTERING BOX LOCATION

Engraved box numbers on the base of each box simplify registration of GPS location and occupancy activity monitoring.
